



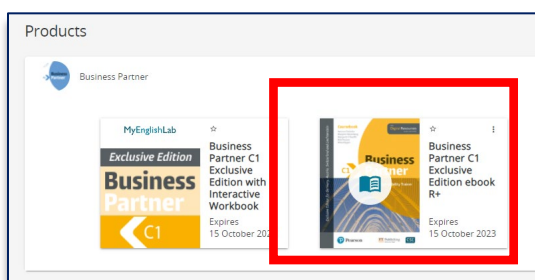

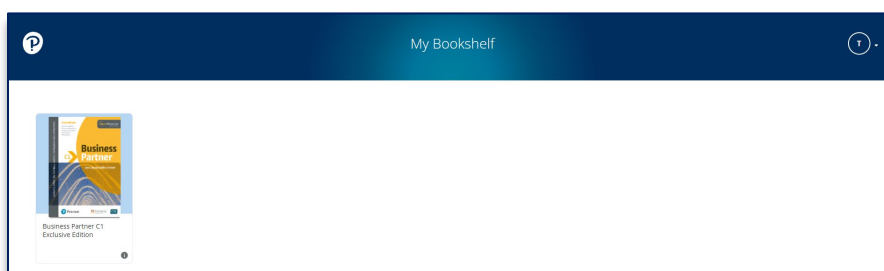

Accessing eBooks

1. Check the system requirements for eBooks [here](#).
2. Create a Pearson English Portal account - as described [here](#) or log in to an existing account [here](#).
3. Add your access code (product) if necessary - as described [here](#).
4. From the Pearson English Portal dashboard, click on the tile as indicated in red below:



You will then be re-directed to your bookshelf as shown below. *Note: Clearing you cache and allowing pop-ups may be helpful if the eBook is not properly displayed.*



Click on the book cover to open the book and start reading.

If you wish to download our Reader+ app to access your eBook on a mobile device or your desktop, please click [here](#) and select the option for your device. Then follow the onscreen instructions.

*Note: To use the content offline, you first need to download the content to your device. An Internet connection is required when you first log in and download your content. Once your content is downloaded, provided that you **do not log out** of the app, you will be able to access the content offline.*
